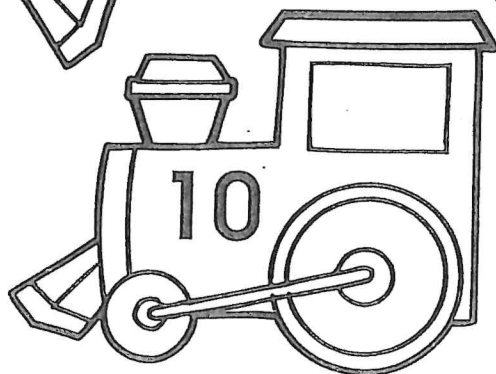
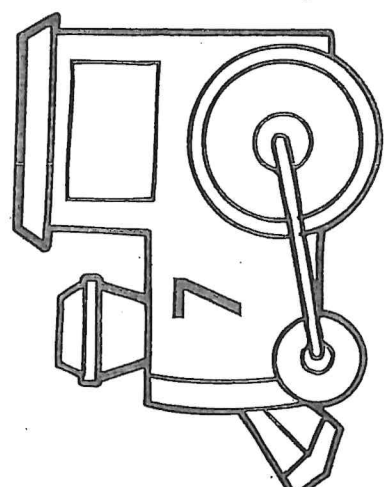
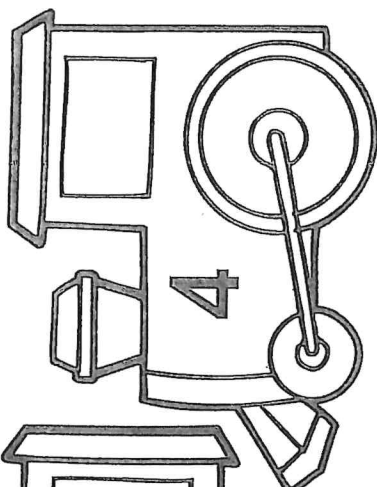
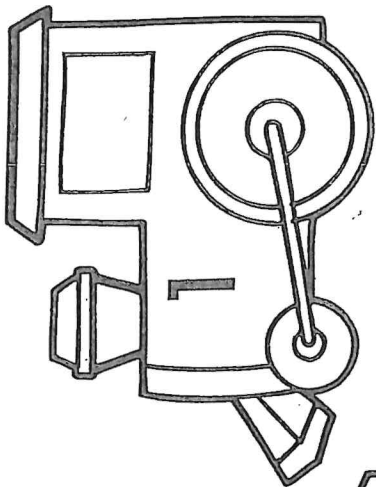
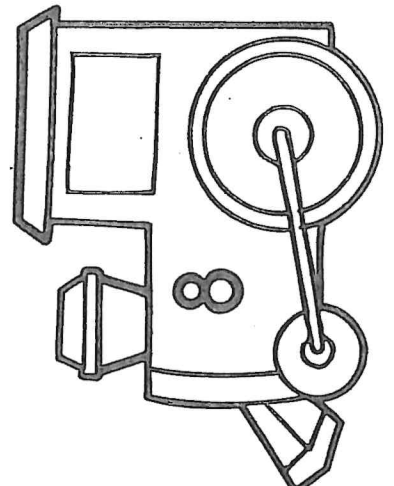
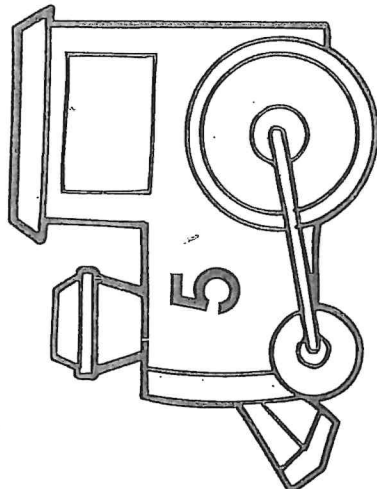
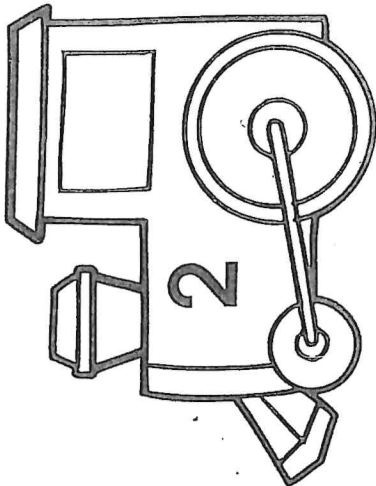
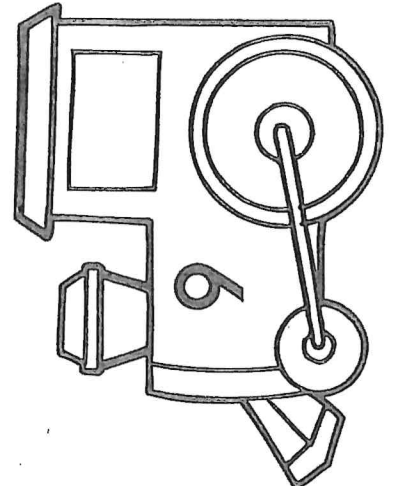
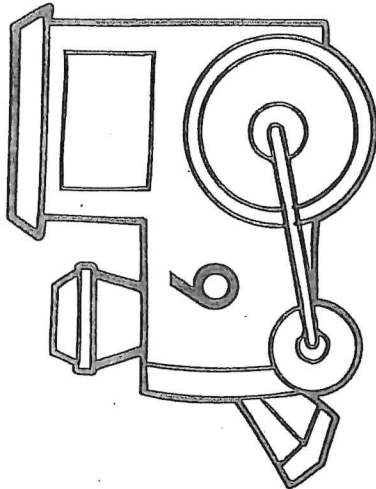
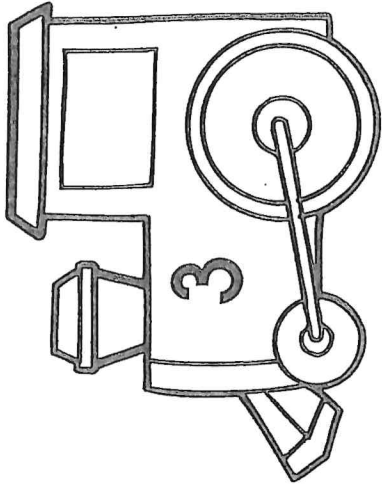
Railroad Math- A Game For All Ages

GAME INSTRUCTIONS

- 1) Color and cut apart railroad cars and engines.
- 2) To play the game, place engines face down in the middle of the table.
- 3) Each player in turn, picks an engine and proceeds to attach railroad cars until the number of cars matches the number on the engine.

Example: Player picks an engine with the number 5 on it. Player lays down the engine and places 5 railroad cars behind it to form a train.
